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**Le Bocce 2014 Chianti Classico**

**89 Points**

Made with Sangiovese and 5% Canaiolo, this opens with aromas of iris, black-skinned berry and leafy underbrush. The juicy palate delivers black cherry, clove and white pepper alongside brisk acidity and polished tannins. Drink through 2021.

**Le Bocce 2012 Gran Selezione (Chianti Classico)**

**88 Points**

This has delicate aromas of blackberry, tobacco and white pepper that follow through to the medium-bodied palate alongside a star anise note. Taut tannins provide tight support. Drink through 2021.

**Le Bocce 2013 Riserva (Chianti Classico)**

**88 Points**

Made entirely with Sangiovese, this opens with aromas of red plum, cedar and espresso while the firm palate offers dried black cherry, toast and licorice. Closed-grained, rather astringent tannins provide the setting.
